IMPORTANT Information regarding the April Vacation Care Program:

- Families using the service for the first time must complete full Enrolment Form before care can be provided and bookings accepted. Enrolment Forms are available via email or at the service. Returning families are required to ensure that they have updated any information that may have changed.
- ★ All places booked & confirmed after closing date are final. Bookings are subject to staffing, venue availability and may become fully booked prior to the closing date. Bookings are requested to be in by COB Friday, 6pm, 7th April. All excursion/incursions and transport costs are paid in advance by the centre and staff are rostered according to bookings. Once you have made a booking your account will be charged for cancellations or absences MADE WITHIN the Vacation Care Period. Vacation Care Statements will be emailed to families. Full payment of vacation care fees must be paid within 14days of receiving your invoice statement. (Please refer to our Fee Policy)



- ☆ We ask that you please refrain from sending your children if they are unwell or present any cold/flu like symptoms.
- Medication Paperwork— All children with diagnosed medical conditions must have their medication and relevant paperwork on site in order to attend. This includes: risk minimisation plan, communication plan, and an Action Plan signed by a doctor. Upon arrival the medication needs to be signed in with a staff member and must be in original prescribed container with child's name. (Please speak with the Director for further info)

*** VACATION CARE PROGRAM GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- Child Care Subsidy: This fee reduction is available for eligible families who meet government requirements. Contact the Department of Human Services (DHS) on 13 61 50 for further information. Families will be liable for the gap fee if you are eligible for these rebates, otherwise full fees apply! Daily cost is shown on the booking form. New families must provide Enfield OSHC with the date of births and Centrelink reference numbers of their child(ren) and parent who registered for CCS. If this information is not provided you may be required to pay full fees until your CCS entitlements are confirmed.
- ☆ Vacation Care Bookings **will not be accepted** from families with fees in arrears.
- Signing IN / OUT: Children must be escorted into the service and signed in by an authorized person. All authorized people to collect must use their OWN personal 4-digit pin which is provided on the sign in/out iPad. Please inform staff when arriving and leaving. It is also a safety requirement that all children be signed in and out of OSHC so staff can accurately account for all children in the event of an emergency.

- ☆ For in Centre days 1 Educator: 15 children.
- ☆ For excursions 1 Educator: 8 children.
- ☆ Water Days 1 Educator: 5 children

A thorough Risk Assessment is undertaken for each excursion. Families may view these Risk Assessments at any time. Please speak to one of our friendly staff.

☆ Rules around bringing personal items:

- NO devices of such or sentimental toys are allowed in the centre. OSHC has resources to cater to your child needs/ or sensory requirements. Please leave valuable items at home.
- ☆ For the safety of all children ENCLOSED SHOES MUST BE WORN WHILE THEY ARE ATTENDING VACATION CARE.

At Enfield OSHC we follow the SunSmart guidelines, all children are required to:

Wear OSHC sun safe hat (Hat with your child's name is provided and remains property of OSHC) Sunscreen will be supplied by the service during regular routines, if your child is sensitive, please supply sunscreen in their bag and advise staff upon arrival.

- Always wear appropriate clothing, e.g., children's shoulders must be covered, no singlet/strap tops, as they are not considered as SunSmart clothing. This includes a t-shirt/rash shirt to be worn on all pool days. Thongs are only allowed on water-based activities, but also bring closed toe shoes for back at OSHC.
- ☆ During Vacation Care breakfast is available at the centre until 8.15am.
- Please ensure you pack: RECESS, LUNCH, AND SNACKS ALONG WITH A WATER BOTTLE.
 Afternoon snack is provided but not on excursion days. However, if available fruit is on offer on these days.
 If lunch etc. is provided by the centre a cost of \$6.00 will be added to your account.
- BEHAVIOUR: Children must follow the rules and procedures of OSHC. Consequences for inappropriate behaviour will be followed including discussions with parents, withdrawal from activities and reflection time.
 The Centre reserves the right to cancel a participant's enrolment should their behaviour be deemed unacceptable.
