Please ensure you read the below information as it may have changed.

Terms and Conditions

Enrolment:

Families using our service for the first time will need to complete an OSHC Enrolment Form before care can be given or bookings accepted. Enrolment forms are available via email or at the service.

Returning families are required to ensure that they have updated any information that may have changed.

Spaces available for Vacation Care bookings are subject to staffing, venue availability and may become fully booked prior to the closing date. Bookings are requested to be in **by Monday**, **5pm**, **5**th **December** to support staffing arrangements and allow the service to order resources & materials.

All excursion/incursions and transport costs are paid in advance by the centre and staff are rostered according to bookings. Once you have made a booking for a session you will be billed irrespective of whether you use that session or not.

Bookings are available by filling in the OSHC Vacation Care Booking form and <u>returning to OSHC directly or via</u> <u>email.</u> Term time bookings do not roll over into Vacation Care.

All bookings are subject to families accounts not being overdue.

Daily Costs:

The cost shown is before any Childcare Subsidy Rebates which reduce these costs. Government subsidies up to 85% may apply, please speak with Centrelink or log onto MyGov and register if you are eligible for these rebates. **\$60** per centre home days | **\$64.00** per incursion days | **\$68.00** per excursion days

Child Care Subsidy:

The cost of care in Out of School Hours Care and Vacation Care varies according to each families Child Care Subsidy (CCS), which is based on their activity test. Contact the Department of Human Services (DHS) on 13 61 50 for further information.

Families eligible for Childcare Subsidy can receive up to 42 subidised absent days per financial year. These absences are provided by the government to assist families and services if children are unwell or the family do not notify the service within the require time frame. Families will be liable for the gap fee.

Vacation Care Cancellations:

Once a Vacation Care booking is made, families can cancel up to <u>closing date on program prior</u>, by 5pm via email and not incur a charge. Any cancellations after <u>5pm</u>, <u>prior</u> or failure to notify the service of non-attendance will be charged full fee and the session will be marked as absent.

COVID-19:

In the event of a COVID-19 situation, the service will follow SA health advice and inform families as soon as reasonably possible, if applicable.

Please be aware waiving of relevant fees will be subject to our standard cancellation policy unless the Government provide alternative support measures for families and services to remain viable.

Sun Protection:

Clothing should be sun smart. No singlets or tops that do not cover shoulders. Children will not be permitted to play outside without a hat which one is provided and remains property of OSHC. Closed toe shoes are to be worn at all times and **NO** jewelry/ watches allowed, only studded earrings. **Sunscreen is applied during warmer months or when the UV is 3 or above.**

Attendance Records:

All children must be signed IN and OUT of the program with exact times of dropping off and collection by an approved authorised person listed on their OSHC enrolment forms.

Not signing your child in/out each day will require families to reconfirm their child's attendance data and may affect the families CCS entitlements for the day resulting in full fees being charged. The service may not be able to amend the bookings after the day so we encourage families to please make sure you are signing your children IN and OUT. Please advise staff when you arrive and when you collect your child/children for safety concerns.

Collection of Children:

For safety, children will only be released to authorised adults that are named on the enrolment forms. Children must be signed in/out by their parent, or other authorised person, before they leave the OSHC grounds (must be 18yrs). Children must be collected by 6.00pm.

If the collection person is late because of an emergency, please notify OSHC as soon as possible on **0401 993 850** so that appropriate arrangements can be made.

Late fees apply after 6.00pm (please refer to Fees policy for Late Collection fees).

Food:

The service provides breakfast before 8am and snack on certain days. Children must bring their own water bottle, recess and lunch each day. Ensure an ice brick is placed in your child's lunch box. Please do not send food that needs reheating, cooking or hot water added, such as noodles. If the center requires to provide your child with food, it will be @ a cost of \$5.00 payable on the day. This also includes if a water bottle is supplied.

Staffing Ratios:

On site - one staff member per 15 school aged children.

On excursion – excursion ratios are based on a risk assessment. Please refer to the program for specific ratios on any given day.

At all times there will be a minimum of one staff member with an approved Education & Care qualification per 30 children and First Aid Certificate.

Illness/Medication:

We ask all families to keep their child/ren home if they are unwell. If a child shows signs of illness, families will be contacted immediately and sent home.

Medication Paperwork— a Medical Management Plan and a Risk Minimisation/Communication Plan must be completed for every child with a medical condition attending Vacation Care. All medications must be handed to a staff member on arrival at OSHC and in prescribed original packaging.

No medication will not be administered without the correct updated documentation for the OSHC service which may vary from the school plans.

Children will not be allowed to attend the OSHC service in the event of medical supplies and information specific to your child is not provided to the service.

Excursions:

To avoid disappointment, get your bookings in early as excursions book out quickly. Children are not allowed to bring spending money.

In the event that the forecast temperature is 35 degrees on a day where an outdoor excursion has been planned, the excursion will be cancelled. A Home-based day (with a similar theme) will be held, with families being charged the home day charge. Children must arrive for excursions as time stated on the program – we will not wait or contact any late arrivals and assume you will be absent.

This allows staff time to talk to the whole group about:

- Safety issues
- Behaviour expectations
- Organise children's belongings for the day i.e., lunch, recess, and water bottles
- Toileting
- Sunscreen application
- Groups of children.

Risk Assessments:

A thorough Risk Assessment is undertaken for each excursion/incursion/activity. Each Risk Assessment details time schedules, transport methods and route details, safety harness requirements, transport embarking/disembarking procedures, staffing arrangements, activities to be undertaken, entry procedures, possible risks/hazards, and steps to minimise these to ensure child/educator's safety. Families may view these Risk Assessments at any time (please speak to staff).

Payment of fees:

Enfield OSHC bills a week in arrears, therefore your bill will be received by Tuesday or Wednesday, for the Monday to Sunday prior. Therefore, any payments made after that period will appear on your next statement. Please be aware that transactions have processing days and sometimes do not appear on the day you process it.

During Vacation Care invoices/statements and reconciliation of payments may be delayed due to finance officer being on leave and may also be delayed due to the Director being on the floor. We ask that you keep track of relevant payments and pay the outstanding based on what you have previously paid. Every effort will be made to keep the schedule as per normal for Invoices / Statements. **Payment is still required to be made within 7 days or reminders and debt collection processes may occur.**



Extreme weather: Please note that in the event of extreme weather conditions / incursions, excursions or covid may change or be cancelled. Other activities will be provided in this instance. Mobile phones and personal belongings are not permitted in the center.

Our service adheres to the SunSmart Guidelines.



PLEASE NOTE

Once a Vacation Care booking is made, families who cancel their booking during vacation care full fees apply.

Avoid absent fee: The required notice on program or more to avoid the absent gap (CCS) or full fee (non-CCS) being charged.

Cancellations: Can be made via email or in person. By closing date on program!

Through CCS (Childcare Subsidy) families are provided with up to 42 absent days per child, per financial year to support families, meaning if you are receiving CCS, you only have the gap for any absences unless you have used all absent days.

If you do not utilize the service for a 14-week period and if your child's last booked session(s) were marked as absent, you will be liable for paying full-fee on all absent sessions. Even though CCS may have been applied initially, Centrelink will revoke this and your account will go into debit and our standard debt collection process will occur. This is a Centrelink mandate and not put in place by Enfield OSHC

- I understand that as part of my enrolment at this service it is required that I confirm acceptance to the following items for this service to receive government funding on my behalf. Acceptance of these items as well as some of the other information in the enrolment form can be used as a complying written arrangement for child care subsidy purposes.
- □ I understand that if my child/ren does not have appropriate clothing needed for that day they will not be allowed to participate and may be excluded from participating during excursions/outdoors. *Clothing must be in line with our sun safe policy.* <u>Hats worn Term 1 & 4 unless UV 3 an above</u>.
- □ I understand that the Centre cannot cater for sick children and that I am required to exclude my child from care during illness as per Centre policies.
- □ I must provide all food required for my child for the day unless the program indicates otherwise. If food is provided a charge *WILL* occur of \$5.00 and charged to your account.
- □ I understand if my child creates constant disruptions to the program, the Centre reserves the right to suspend or withdraw the child's enrolment after consultation with the parents.
- Standard sign-in/out procedures apply. I am responsible for the delivery and collection of my child to/from the service. I have read the Parent Key Information and conditions of enrolment carefully. I understand and accept the terms and conditions as listed.

Vacation Care Behaviour Guidelines

OSHC Parent/caregiver agreement Please read to your child/ren

For the students to understand better what these mean for their behaviour we ask that they consider their actions before acting upon them. We understand that on occasions they are going to make errors in judgment and below is an outline of what you can expect educators and children to do in these situations.

- Always listen to what the staff are saying and follow their instructions.
- Participate! Join in with all the games and activities. You will have a great time.
- Stay with the group you are always in on excursions.
- Stay within the boundaries when we are outside or on excursion. Ask a staff member if you can leave to get a drink or go to the toilet.
- \blacktriangleright Play sensibly with the other children and take care of our equipment.
- If you need anything, tell one of the staff they can always help.
- Be kind to each other and work at playing together.
- Most important- Appropriate behaviour choices always. We would not like you to miss out!
- Our OSHC Service has a zero tolerance to aggressive behaviour. Aggressive behaviour is defined as:
 - Physical violence towards educators or children
 - Throwing large items to cause injury
 - Excessive threatening/ bullying behaviour towards educators or children
 - Excessive abusive language to educators or children

If any of the above behaviours are used in the OSHC Service, the following procedures will be implemented:

Warning 1: The family will be notified of the behaviour and the child is removed from the OSHC Service for the remainder of the day and will be suspended for the next day of care.

Warning 2: The child is suspended from the OSHC Service for 1 calendar week

Warning 3: The child is permanently suspended from the OSHC Service.
